

MUS 310/311 : Applied Music: Vocal and Instrumental III

Students may select from the following: piano, voice, flute, violin, cello, guitar or another instrument upon request, subject to the availability of instructors. Level of instruction and credits are dependent on ability and are assigned after an initial assessment; no audition is necessary. Course content varies from term to term. A fee is charged per credit.
