

SHS 485 : Sociology and Human Services Internship

Through this minimum 160-hour internship students gain professional experience by applying skills learned in their sociology class work. Students may choose from a variety of internship options including community and government agencies, the criminal justice system, non-profits, or others that assist entry into a professional career. Students must work with a full-time sociology faculty member as their faculty sponsor. Graded Pass/Fail. Prerequisites: SHS major; junior standing or above; pre-internship seminar; permission of faculty sponsor and the Dean for the School of Business and Social Sciences.
